
SUNGEI TENGAH LODGE

1. 3 Nov 2022 Visit by MOM – ACE (Operation)

MOM Director (Special Project) Mr. Thng Chee Meng, together with 6 ACE staff visited STL on 3 Nov 2022. They were briefed on the Sungei Tengah Lodge facilities and dormitory operation.

The sharing includes the detailed activities carried out from the start of the Covid19 Pandemic and STL experiences in providing services like food catering, medical support and necessary control measures to safeguard the health and welfare of the foreign workers residing in STL

2. Traffic Safety in STL

There is a step-up effort by STL management to ensure a high standard of traffic safety in STL because of latest full occupancy of STL and increase traffic during the morning peak hours.

Our Security Department will pay special attention to the following:

1. Speeding vehicle during the morning peak hours
2. Congestion and smooth traffic at the Electronic Parking System (EPS) gantry
3. Illegal parking and waiting vehicle obstructing traffic flow

Some additional measures that will be taken

1. Additional road humps will be constructed to slow traffic
2. Wheel clamp and fines for recalcitrant drivers
3. Immediate repair for any EPS breakdown.

3. 17 Nov 2022 Visit by MOM – ACE (Medical)

ACE Dy Chief (Operation) Christine Loh together with ACE Chief Medical Office Dr Lee plus supporting staff visited STL. The visit agenda was to understand the operation of STL and to discussed on the On-site Medical Centre (OMC) services.

There was a short presentation on the chronology of events starting from the beginning of the Covid 19 outbreak, followed by Isolation Order issued by MOH and all the medical services and support given to the foreign workers residing in STL.

There were discussions on current OMC SATA services, usage of spaces and request for services be extended for public holidays plus earlier start time 8.30am and later end time 9.30pm.

5. 21 Nov 2022 Visit by 40 staff teachers from QiHua Primary School


In 2020, QiHua Primary School has generously donated food items to the foreign workers staying in STL

In 21 Nov 2022, delegates comprising 40 teachers and staff members visited STL. They again brought along the school children’s donated items for the residents. STL management did a 2 hours presentation sharing of the relentless effort and difficult times experienced STL staff to provide security, food services, medical support and enforcement of all authorities and agencies’ requirements while looking after the welfare (including more cleaning and clearing of rubbish) of the residents during their confinement period in STL. The presentation was an eye-opener to them. Later the delegates tour the STL facilities and the delegates were divided into 5 groups to go to each cluster to help to decorate and string-up the decorations that they brought along.

The school presented a small pottery gift to STL, and a week after, the principal Mrs. Lee personally deliver to STL a fruit hamper plus 5 ‘thank you’ notes signed by the staff. Very thoughtful. Thank you.
