1. Morning Traffic Management

In the weekly operation meetings, morning traffic safety issues were raised given the heavy human and vehicle traffic of more than 20,000 residents going to their workplaces at the same time. The high risks were standing or sitting residents in front of parked vehicles. The haphazard pick-up of workers, usage of zebra crossing and clogged yellow junction box affecting vehicles traffic flow. STL decided to add more staff to manage the morning traffic and designated pick-up areas were identified for employers with many employees residing in Sungei Tengah Lodge (STL). These 2 weeks exercise and implementation measures has resulted vast improvement in a better and more regulated morning traffic management.
